Sherwood & Anna Maria J. his wife of Toledo Lucas County, Ohio do acknowledge of One hundred and Sixty Dollars to me paid by Leander Burdick the Receipt whereof & hereby acknowledged, do hereby Release, Release and forever last, claim to the said Leander Burdick and his heirs and assigns forever.

Lot Number Nine 9 of the Rebbings Subdivision of Land on MiddlePop Island as shown by plat Executed August 17, 1874 of record in the Recorders Office of Ottawa County, Ohio together with the Common and joint use of the Streets laid out in said plat, and also of the Right of way from the Lands of the Toledo & Lake Erie Boating and Fishing Association along the Bank adjoing the Lake to connect with the County Road and the use of the Rebbing dock and the groves in common with the Owners of the Lots 1 to 11. in said Subdivision the same as the said Rights and privileges are granted to the said Sherwood by said Rebbing by deed dated Aug 17 1874. All of said Rights of way, use of dock and groves so granted to said Sherwood by said Rebbing to be for the joint use of the grantee herein in common with all the Owners of the Lots 1. to 11. afterward. Also the Right to Beverage and to lay Water or gas pipes through the Rear or Sides of any of the said eleven Lots to the Lot hereby conveyed and reserving to the Owner of any of the said Lots 1. to 11. the Right to go through the Rear or Sides of the Lot hereby Conveyed with Sewer, Water or Gas Pipe to the Lot of the said Owner, or any Main Sewer or pipe put in for the drainage or accumulation of said eleven Lots or the Owners thereof and all the Estate, Title and Interest of the said Francis P. Sherwood either in Law or in Equity of, in and to the said premises. Together with all the Privileges and Appurtenances to the same belonging, and all the Rights, Issues and profits thereof;

To Have and to Hold the same to the only proper use of the said Leander Burdick, heirs and assigns forever. In Witness Whereof, the said Francis P. Sherwood and Anna Maria D. Sherwood, Wife of Francis P. Sherwood hereby Release her Right and Expectancy of dower in the said premises, have hereunto set their hands and Seal, this Seventeenth day of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy four.
