

William Rehberg & Wife To Thomas E. Bond

Know all men by these presents that I William Rehberg of the County of Ottawa and State of Ohio in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty dollars in hand paid by Thomas E. Bond of Toledo Lucas County Ohio bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Thomas E. Bond his heirs and assigns from the following premises situate in the County of Ottawa in the State of Ohio and in the Township of Put In Bay bounded and described as follows.

Lot No Thirteen (13) in Rehberg's Subdivision of Land on Middle Bass Island as shown by plat executed August 17th 1874 of record in the Recorder's Office of Ottawa County Ohio together with the joint use of the streets laid in said plat. And also of the Right of way from the Lands of the Toledo and Lake Erie Boating and fishing association along the bank against the lake to connect with the County road, and the use of the Rehberg's dock and piers in common with the owners of the Lots One (1) to Eleven (11) in said subdivision the same as the said rights and privileges are granted to the said Ishenwood Gould Rehberg by deed dated August 17th 1874. All of said rights of way use of dock and piers so granted to said Ishenwood by said Rehberg, to be for the joint use of the Grantees herein in common with all the owners of the Lots One to Eleven aforesaid, to have and to hold said premises with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas E. Bond his heirs and assigns forever. And the said William Rehberg for himself and his executors Administrators and heirs do hereby covenant with the said Thomas E. Bond his heirs and assigns that he is lawfully seized of the premises aforesaid that the premises are free and clear from all encumbrances whatever and that he will forever warrant and defend the same with the appurtenances unto the said Thomas E. Bond his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever. And be it further known that Louise Rehberg wife of the above named grantor in consideration of one dollar to her in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby release release and forever quit claim to said Grantee his heirs and assigns all her right title and interest in and to the above granted Premises either by way of donee or otherwise. In testimony Whereof we the said William Rehberg and Louise Rehberg his wife have hereunto set their hands and seal this fourth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and Seventy four
