To the Members Middle Bass Club:-

I take pleasure in advising the members of the Middle Bass Club that under a contract with the Trustees, I will have charge of the Club property for the coming season. The services of a competent Chef have been secured, and every effort will be made to provide satisfactory service to members and their guests, commencing in May, for the accommodation of fishing parties.

The Club will be opened for the regular summer season on Saturday, June 26th. A limited number can be received prior to that date if advance notice be given.

Members will be met at Burns' dock (Wehrle's) by the Club bus, or if more convenient to come via Put-in-Bay, by the Roper.

THE ATTENTION OF COTTAGE OWNERS IS INVITED TO THE FOLLOWING:-

If any repairing or painting of cottages is desired, I will be pleased to submit an estimate of the cost, on receipt of advice as to the nature and extent of the work, and believe I can do such work for members at lower rates than would be obtainable elsewhere. This work could only be done before the opening of the Club, however, and early notice is therefore necessary.

Members who would like to rent or sell their cottages are requested to name their terms, as I have several inquiries from responsible parties who might be interested.

I will arrange to open and clean cottages, when notified and to properly close them at the end of the season, for \$5.00. Will also furnish chambermaid service, if desired, at the rate of \$4.00 per week.

Water and gas will be provided for cottagers, charge for the former being \$6.00 per month. No rate can be quoted on the gas, as this charge will depend upon the size of the Cottage and number of Cottages opened.

I will take care of Cottage Grounds same as last year for \$10.00 the season. It is essential that you advise me at once in regard to care of Cottage Grounds, as it is my desire to have the grounds more beautiful than ever.
